Ellen : Not so often. We come here only on special days. Now, let's take a look at the menu.

Ichi : Wow! There are so many foods on the menu. In Japanese restaurants, menus usually have a lot of photos of the foods on them, so we can easily tell what kind of food they are serving. But here, menus have no photos. I'm not sure what to order.

Ellen : Don't worry. I'll help you. It will be a good practice for you to learn how to order food in the U.S.

Server: Hi.  B

Ellen : I'll have a glass of white wine, please. Ichi, how about you?

Ichi : Orange juice, please.

Server: All right. I'll be right back with your drinks.

Ellen : Now, let's order food. I think I'll have a steak.

Ichi : Let me see... Without photos, I can't imagine what all these foods taste like. I'm sorry, but I always take time to pick food from the menu even in Japan.

Ellen : Don't worry. Take your time.

Ichi : Do you think they serve every dish in a big portion?

Ellen : Probably. You know, we are in America. Everything comes in a big size here.

Ichi : Well, I will feel bad if I can't finish all.

Ellen : Oh, you don't have to worry about that. In that case, we can ask for a doggy bag.

Ichi : A doggy bag? What is it?

Ellen : It is a bag for taking home any food that is left after a meal in a restaurant.

Ichi : Is that possible? In Japan, we don't usually do such a thing. That's a very good system!

Ellen : You think so. Umm... I think we should order now.

Ichi : Well, then... I'll have a hamburger.

Ellen : (to the server) Excuse me!

Server: Are you ready to order?

Ellen : Yes, can I have a steak with French fries, please?

Server: All right.  C

Ellen : Medium rare, please. (To Ichi) Ichi, あなたの番よ。

Ichi : Could I have a hamburger, please?

Server: Would you like it with French fries?

Ichi : Yes, please.

Server: Anything else?

Ellen : No, that's all, thank you.

(After some time, the two finish their dinner)

Ellen : I'm glad that you finished your hamburger. Did you like it?

Ichi : Yes, that was delicious. It is much bigger than I thought, but I liked it so much.

Ellen : Great.

(The server comes to their table)

Server: Are you finished? How was everything?

Ellen : They were all delicious, thank you. D

Server: Sure.

Ichi : When you pay the bill at restaurants, do you have to add a tip? How do you do that?

Ellen : Usually you pay 15 to 20 percent of the total price to the server. You can pay a tip by cash or credit card. Today, I'm going to pay by card, so I can just write the amount of my tip here.

Ichi : That sounds like a lot of trouble and extra money.

Ellen : Well, it is a part of American culture. I'm happy to pay if you enjoyed the dinner tonight.

Ichi : Yes, I really enjoyed the food. Thank you so much for a lovely dinner.

Ellen : My pleasure. We can visit here again while you stay with us.

5 マサヒロ (Masahiro) のダイエットに関する発表を読み、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Have you ever gone on a diet? There are many ways to lose weight. I tried three types of diets. Now I will explain.

First, replacement diet. In this diet, you change your food to another one. For example, if you eat bread and salad for breakfast every day, you eat only one food like apples or soup instead of bread and salad. It has an effect on losing weight because you eat less than usual. I could lose three kilograms in a week. However, it is bad for our health. In my case I fell down. So you should know you may become sick when you try this diet.

The second one is fasting diet. Fasting means not eating anything all day. It came from Ramadan, an event for Muslims. They can't eat, drink, or smoke during the day while the sun is up. So in fasting diet, you must not eat anything for some days. How can we do that? If you have never tried this, I recommend you to do a short fast. It will continue for three days. First day, you can eat healthy food and eat less. The second day is the most important and hardest day. You can eat nothing. But you can drink water as much as you want. Also, you can drink other kinds of drink like smoothies in which fruits and ice cream are mixed. On the final day, you can eat a healthy meal like noodles or soup. After this, I could lose two kilograms.

Both of them may have problems for our health so I think the most effective and safest way is exercise. If you are not good at exercise, you can start by walking. You have to walk fast and walk more than twenty minutes. 歩くことはあなたの体を健康に保ちます。 And you can be relaxed. Dancing is also good for your body. We can do exercise or dance while watching TV or YouTube at home. I was able to lose seven kilograms, but it took a very long time. Six months!

There are many ways to diet, but I think exercise is the most effective. If you want to be a healthy and good-looking person, why don't you start exercising every day?

**7** 次の英文を読み、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Humans don't always understand animals' feelings. We often think that animals have the same thoughts and feelings as humans. But we are often wrong. For example, we may think a dolphin is happy because its mouth looks like a smile. But the shape of a dolphin's mouth doesn't change. It doesn't mean the dolphin is smiling. When chimpanzees smile, it means they feel afraid. This feeling is very different from happiness.

Here is a question: Do dogs dislike rain? Let's think about this question. Sometimes we think that we know how an animal feels, but we can easily make a mistake. Dogs are very close friends of humans but do we really understand them? Some people put raincoats on their dogs on rainy days. 【 A 】 Maybe they have seen that their dogs don't want to go out in rainy weather. They decide, of course, that their dogs don't like rain.

Dogs dislike rain. It is easy to think this because humans don't like getting wet. But is it right to think like this? Are there any facts to support it? If a dog sees the raincoat, it becomes excited and moves its tail a lot. This may mean that the dog likes wearing the raincoat. But it may also mean that when the dog sees the raincoat, it understands that the raincoat means it is time to go for a walk. 【 B 】

If we think about wolves, maybe it will help us. Wolves are wild but they are close to dogs. Wolves and dogs have their own natural coats, which are made of \*fur. 【 C 】 This fact may mean that dogs do not need or want a raincoat.

If we want to understand animals, we have to realize that animals are not like humans. We need to learn more about animal feelings and actions. Then we will learn to understand what animals really want. So you need to learn the language of dogs!
