6 日本人のマサ (Masa) が夏休みの思い出を友人のトム (Tom) と話しています。2 人の会話を読み、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Masa: Hi, Tom! Long time no see! How are you?

Tom : Hello, Masa. I'm good. How are you? I heard you went somewhere last summer.

Masa: Yes. I went to Cambodia to visit the World Heritage Site *Angkor Wat.

Tom : Wow! I'm so jealous. I've never been abroad. Tell me how you went to Cambodia.

Masa: Well, there's no direct flight to Cambodia from Japan, so I had to transfer in Singapore. The flight time in total was about nine hours.

Tom : Long flight! You must have been tired. I don't know about Angkor Wat very much.

Masa: OK. Angkor Wat is one of the *ruins of Angkor, and the most popular tourist attraction in Cambodia. It was built in the 12th century as a Hindu temple, but gradually changed into a Buddhist temple. Isn't it interesting?

Tom : It is! It has a long history. So, has Angkor Wat always been popular in the world?

Masa: Actually it hasn't. Angkor Wat was known among Cambodian people, but other people didn't know the *existence of it. When the French visited the temple and introduced it into the world in the 19th century, people around the world came to know about Angkor Wat.

Tom : I see. Are they big or small?

Masa: Very big. The size of the ruins is about the same size as central Tokyo. All things are protected in this area including the ruins, people, forest, rice fields and the way of living, because they are registered as a World Heritage.

Tom : Oh. I didn't know even the people's culture is protected as World Heritage. It is very important to *preserve not only the ruins but also the people's way of life. It is *diverse.

Masa: Yes. その場所に入るためにはチケットを買わないといけないよ。 We can protect the area with the money.

Tom : How much?

Masa: It depends on how many days you want to visit and what nationality you are. If you are non-Cambodian, and you want to stay just one day, it is 37 dollars. Tom : I think the price is not so expensive for protecting the area.

Masa: I stayed for a week, so I spent 72 dollars for the ticket. The site has so many places to see that I think we should stay for at least one week to visit all the ruins. I wanted to stay longer when I left Cambodia.

Tom : I want to visit Angkor Wat after listening to your story.

Masa: Do you? Let's go together next summer because it is the rainy season and the temperature is cooler than in the dry season!

First, let's look at the good sides of smartphones. Smartphones help people stay in touch with others. You can easily send text messages, make phone calls, and even have video calls with family and friends even when they are far away. Smartphones are also helpful for learning. There are many *apps that help students with their studies, such as apps for reading books, practicing math, or even learning new languages. Besides learning, smartphones are also fun. I usually play games, watch videos, or listen to music. These things can help me relax after a long day.

But smartphones also have some bad sides. One of the main problems is that some people cannot stop using smartphones. They spend too much time using their phones, and this may be harmful to their health. For example, looking at the screen for a long time can hurt your eyes, and playing games or using apps late at night can make it hard to sleep. Another problem is that smartphones can make people spend too much time alone. When people spend too much time on their phones, they might talk to fewer people face-to-face. They may have some trouble in communicating with friends in person.

Then, how can we protect children from using smartphones too much? Parents should set rules for how long their children can use their phones each day. It is important to make sure children have enough time to study, play outside, and spend time with family. Parents should also talk to their children about the dangers of using smartphones too much, such as *addiction and health problems. Finally, parents should be good examples. If parents use smartphones in a balanced way, their children will learn how to use them responsibly, too.
